We are pleased to provide you with a copy of our new spring price list. **This list cancels all previous lists.** We hope that you will find something of interest. We grow alpines & rock garden plants, including many dwarf shrubs, acid loving plants, and ferns as well as various other interesting plants from time to time. We grow only plants that we like and find interesting, and tend not to be constrained by categories!

All of our plants are grown on the nursery site, sometimes in small numbers per variety. As a result the stock situation can change suddenly. Some items can sell out quickly and unlisted varieties often become available throughout the year. Most of our plants are offered in 6cm to 9cm pots as appropriate for the needs of the plant. **All plants are offered ex nursery subject to their remaining available. Prices given in the list refer to the smallest size normally offered. Larger plants may sometimes be available at different prices.**

We do not supply plants by mail order. However, we will be attending quite a number of Alpine Garden Society, Scottish Rock Garden Club and other shows and can bring plant orders to them. Check that we will be attending and please place orders a week or two in advance of the show if possible.

Please ask if you cannot find what you are looking for. We have extensive growing areas beyond the sales area, and not all of our stock is out on display to customers at any one time. **If you are looking for a number of specific plants in the list, it can save a lot of time if you send your list to us a few days before your visit, so that we can assemble the available plants from the far reaches of the nursery site for you. If you are travelling from a distance to collect specific plants, please ring to check current availability, as some items can sell out very quickly, especially at the start of the season.** We have a large, covered 'Alpine Tunnel' with net sides, in which we can grow and display a large number of alpines. This serves to protect the plants (and our customers) from the extremes of wind & rain to which our site is prone, without making the plants 'soft'.

Notes from the Potting Shed

Welcome to our Spring 2012 availability list, the preparation of which has been very different from last year. Whereas last year we were worrying about what we could include after all the frost and snow, this year it is very mild and we are spoilt for choice, hoping some of the early flowering selections will still be flowering when the season starts.

The snows and extreme temperatures of 2010 and 2011 wrought quite a lot of havoc so we concentrated last year on regenerating good mother plants of many species and cultivars. Mercifully we lost very few alpines completely, so have been able to regenerate most. Notable amongst the total losses were *Hibbertia pedunculata*, *Correa* 'Marian's Marvel' and *Leptospermum* 'Pipit'. If any of you out there still have any of these we would be delighted to swap material!

We are pleased to offer plants of both of our new white flowered Dianthus cultivars this year. *D.* 'Eira Wen' and *D.* 'Seren Wen', are good tight dwarf cushions with white flowers on very short stems. They are both seedlings from *D. freynii* (seed parent) crossed with *D. microlepis* v. *alba*, with characteristics from both parents.

There are various plants we would like to draw your attention to this year. Two of the stunning new Czech Saxifrage cultivars are already in full flower and deserve a place in every collection. *Saxifraga* 'Vercerni Hvezda' ('Evening Star' in English) is reliable and early. It has a large soft primrose yellow flower on a short stem and a slow growing tight cushion. *Saxifraga* 'Verona' also has very large flowers, this time soft shell pink and is even slower to propagate and grow.

We would also recommend *Saxifraga llonakhensis* – from the rarely grown Section Ciliatae. It grows into a neat, rounded cushion with a profusion of bright yellow flowers on short stems in April and promises to make both a good garden and a good show plant.

We have good crops this year of two extremely garden worthy Erythroniums. Our clone of *Erythronium americanum* reliably flowers for us here. The elegant pale clone of *Erythronium hendersonii* which we obtained from Kath Dryden many years ago is pale pink in bud, opening even paler with the characteristic maroon ring of the species. We find it a reliable and welcome addition to the spring garden with more of a tendency to clump up than this species normally does.

We also have a good crop of 3 to 4 year old plants of an unusual Paeony (*P. sp. aff. mlokosewitschii*), grown from a group of Paeony originally obtained as seed of *P. mlokosewitschii* from Halda. The foliage looks right for *P. mlokosewitschii* but it flowers either cream or pink. What it actually is we're not quite sure, but it is free flowering and is a cracking garden plant. (We also have a few slightly younger plants of *Paeonia mlokosewitschii* grown from segregated and hand pollinated plants of the traditional yellow *P. mlokosewitschii* of garden origin.)

We would also recommend the plants we are offering of *Cardiocrinum giganteum*. These are in 9cm pots containing a group of 2-year-old plants ready to grow on and represent very good value for establishing a colony in the garden.

HOW TO FIND US

Visitors are welcome on the nursery during opening hours. The nursery is situated on a minor road just off the A470 between Llandudno Junction and Llanrwst, about 1.5 miles north of Bodnant Gardens. *The nursery cannot be seen from the main A470.* The site commands majestic views towards Snowdonia and the Carneddau.

Visitors coming from the A55 Chester to Holyhead expressway should take the exit for the A470 (**Junction 19**), signposted Betws-y-Coed. Take the A470 through the village of Glan Conwy, past Nev's Garage, set back from the road on your left. Take the next *right* turn, signposted Graig and Aberconwy Nursery, on to a minor road and turn *right* again at the top of the hill. The nursery is about 600 metres on your right.

Visitors coming from the south through Betws-y-Coed and Llanrwst should take the A470 towards Llandudno and Colwyn Bay. After you see the signs for Bodnant Gardens, take the third turn on the left (signposted Graig and Aberconwy Nursery, the first left turn after the No Entry sign). This left turn is soon after Tal Goed garden centre on your right. Follow the minor road to the top of the hill and turn right. Please be warned that the road to the nursery is a single track road with sharp bends and occasional passing places, and please drive carefully.
